B. Conditions to be fulfilled by applicants FOR ADMISSION:

1. Any student seeking admission in Islam Medical College, Sialkot shall mandatorily be required to have passed the HSSC Examination by any Pakistan Board or A level examination by Cambridge Assessment International Education and MDCAT examination held by Pakistan Medical Commission or its nominated University / Agency. The qualification marks for HSSC /A level examination and the MDCAT examination shall be as under;

2. Candidates, who have A-level certificate, will have to furnish, along with their application, an equivalence certificate from the inter-board chairman of committee (IBCC).
3. A student who does not hold a Pakistani nationality be deemed a 'Foreign Student'. The admission of a Foreign Student shall be strictly on the basis of merit. A total of 10 % seats will be allocated for the foreign students. If no or less applications will be received against foreign student's quota, then remaining seats shall be converted into open merit on the recommendation of the Chairman Admission Committee.
4. There shall be no restriction as to domicile of the student.
5. There shall be no age limit for admission in MBBS program.
6. The candidate should possess adequate mental and physical health to continue his/her course of studies.

Ineligibility/ Cancellation of Admission:

1. The candidate must not have been expelled /rusticated from any educational institution.
2. Any students whose degree is not duly verified by the granting institution or credentials are found to be false or forged shall have the admission terminated with immediate effect.

A. MERIT SELECTION CRITERIA / FORMULATION:

The merit list will be prepared by the Admission Committee based on the following;

Intermediate or equivalent	40%
MDCAT	50%
Matric	10%

B. Announcement of the Admission:

Immediately after the announcement of HSSC or MDCAT Results (Whichever will be later).
